"BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Kaukauna Area School District, Outagamie County, Brown County, and Calumet County, Wisconsin shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$198,000,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school facility improvement project consisting of: the construction of a replacement middle school on district-owned land and repurposing the current middle school site; Americans with Disabilities Act compliance updates, capital maintenance, building systems, safety, security, and other site improvements at Park Community Charter School, H.B. Tanner Early Learning Center, Electa Quinney Elementary/New Directions Learning Community, and Kaukauna High School; construction of additions and renovations at Victor Haen Elementary School; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures, and equipment.
